

**CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF COOPER  
KALAMAZOO COUNTY, MICHIGAN**

**RESOLUTION RE: SANITARY SEWER USE CHARGE**

WHEREAS, the Charter Township of Cooper (hereinafter "Township") has adopted the Sewage Disposal System Ordinance, being Ordinance No.193 (hereinafter "Ordinance"), pertaining to the public sewer mains and public sewer service within the Township; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Ordinance, it is the responsibility of the Township Board to determine appropriate fees, charges, and rates relating to connection to and use of the public sanitary sewer system (hereinafter "Sanitary Sewer System"); and

WHEREAS, the Township's Sanitary Sewer System south of D. Avenue is operated by the Gull Lake Sewer and Water Authority (hereinafter "Authority") acting as agent of the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township has received notice from the Authority that effective August 1, 2008, the user fee (also referred to as "sewer use fee") charged to those within the Authority's service area, including that portion in the Township, needs to be increased to help defray increased operational and maintenance costs; and

WHEREAS, this Township Board deems it proper in light of the above that it set the user fee for that portion of the Township's Sanitary Sewer System operated by the Authority at the rate recommended by the Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:

- A. That effective September 1, 2008, the user fee for that portion of the Township's Sanitary Sewer System operated by the Authority shall be increased to \$65.00 per quarter per Residential Equivalent Unit (REU).
- B. That the User Fee shall be payable to the Authority and shall be billed to each customer by the Authority based upon the number of Residential Equivalent Units of each customer as set forth within the Ordinance and as administered by the Authority.
- C. That all prior fees, charges, and rates relating to connection to and use of the Sanitary Sewer System shall continue in effect except as expressly revised herein.
- D. That all resolutions and parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Motion was made by DeHaan, seconded by Sytsma, to adopt the foregoing Resolution.


